## DUTIES OF REGIONAL VICE-PRESIDENTS OF THE DOANE FAMILY ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA, INC.

## 1. From the 2004 Bylaws of The Doane Family Association of America, Inc.:

- **A.** The Regional Vice-Presidents shall form liaison between the Association and Chapters; and with Historical and Genealogical Societies in their respective areas.
- **B.** Shall actively work to establish new Chapters from the National Association's membership list and bring to their attention the advantages of forming local Chapters.
- **C.** Shall, at least once a year, send a list of their Chapter membership as well as a list of the Chapter activities to the First Vice-President.

## 2. Adopted at the 1992 Board of Directors Meeting:

- **A.** Shall make a report to the First Vice-President of the activities of the Chapters in their area, prior to the National biennial reunion.
- **B.** Shall stay informed of Chapter meetings in their area or region and attend when possible.

- **C.** Shall advise the National Association and Chapters of any new Done-Doan-Doane families located in the area and encourage membership in the National Association.
- **D.** Shall encourage or be responsible for Chapter material to get to the Newsletter Editors on time for publication. The current deadline is March 15<sup>th</sup> for the Spring Newsletter and September 15<sup>th</sup> for the Fall Newsletter.
