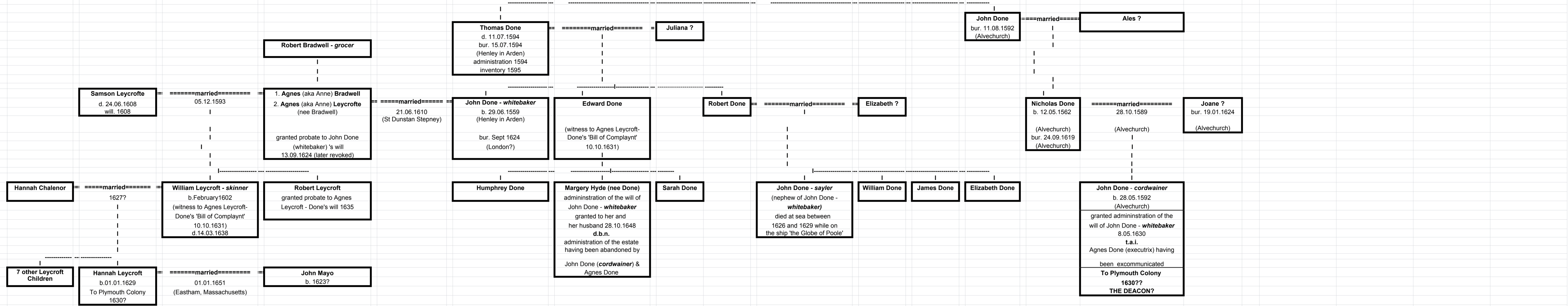


FAMILY TREE OF JOHN DONE - *whitebaker*

NOTES

- (1) Dates shown according to English convention (day/month/year).
- (2) Spellings of the Done surname are as used in John Done *whitebaker*'s will and related testamentary dispute records.
- (3) Spelling in parish records varies, even for the same individual.
- (4) Main sources:

- (5) Abbreviations:
 - t.a.i.- tanquam ab intestato: as of an intestate (estate is treated as if will had not been made)
 - d.b.n.- de bonis non (where estate has been abandoned by administrator)
