

DOANE FAMILY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

In conjunction with Doane College, the Doane Family Foundation has established guidelines and an application for Doane Family Association members to apply for college assistance. We need you to know that a DFA member's child, or grandchild, will not necessarily receive priority assistance. Also, you need to know that your applicant does not have to attend Doane College to receive assistance. Funding of these scholarships by the Doane Family Foundation have in the past several years ranged from \$500 per year to \$5,000 per year. Average assistance has been in the range of \$1,500 per year. We usually give assistance to four or five students per year. We hope to increase our scholarship fund this year, which will enable us to increase our funding in the future. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions regarding the process.

THE PROCESS:

- January 30 Applicants submit the completed Doane Family Scholarship application and a copy of the current year's processed FAFSA results to the Doane Family scholarship organization.
- February 15 Doane Family scholarship organization meets to review all scholarship applications and select potential recipients.
- February 25 Doane Family scholarship organization submits to Doane College for consideration name(s) and recommended scholarship amount(s). Note: the final scholarship amount will be determined after May 1.
- May 15 Doane College informs the Doane Family scholarship organization of its recipients (and financial aid awards), confirms with the recipient(s) their college choice, and requests copy of the recipient's final award notification.

In the early 1990s, I first met Emma when she was visiting her nephew in Culpeper, VA. I drove down and met her and Frank at the motel where they were staying. I had written to her many times before that and she had decided I was to take over for her as historian. I was still teaching at the time and said I was unable to do it. In the next mail, I received an airline ticket from Dulles Airport to Vestal, NY! When Emma made up her mind, you might as well give in. I came home with thirteen disks and started working for her then. When the doctor said she must give up her work as historian, she managed to assure me that I was to take her place. I have visited her several times in her home in Vestal, NY and last talked to her in June before the reunion in Davis, CA.

Emma was a delightful, humorous, spunky lady. She was a member of the United Methodist Church in Endicott, and took her dog with her to church EVERY Sunday. Emma was a Girl Scout leader for many years and a member of the Endicott Women's Club. When she went to the NY DFA reunion and they told her the dog could not attend, she picked up the cake she had brought and went home!!! When she was told that she could no longer drive, she bought a bright red

cadillac. When asked why red, she replied, "I want to be sure those that say I can not drive, see me."

She preferred her typewriter and had no use for computers. Frank would set up the computer and she would keep using the typewriter when he wasn't watching her. I marvel at what she accomplished for the Doane Family and was honored to know her as a friend.
